Mairehau Primary School has a compulsory school uniform code as a means of providing a sense of identity and to try to maintain a high standard of personal presentation.

In enrolling your child and signing the *Annex* you are agreeing to ensure your child(ren) are in correct school uniform at all times. The school uniform is reviewed regularly by the school Board of Trustees and this was done at its meeting on 9 August 2021. As there were no changes the existing code remains in force.

Any clothing worn under the correct uniform such as merinos or tee shirts may only be plain black for Year 1-6 or plain white in Year 7-8. Clothing worn over correct uniform such as jackets, including puffer jackets may only be worn to and from school – not in school.

Students must wear shoes that are appropriate for school. Jandal style, slides, shoes with wheels, heeled or slip-on/ballet style shoes, while fine for weekends or holidays are not suitable footwear for school. Black is the only suitable colour.

New uniform is available for purchase from **The Warehouse**, Northlands Mall.

 A maroon bucket-hat, available from the school office, is to be worn in break times during Terms 4 and 1 (October – April)

ALL CLOTHING SHOULD BE NAMED. Unnamed clothing will be on-sold.

 Second-hand uniform articles in good condition can be on-sold for a nominal fee and are available for purchase from the school office.

Hair longer than shoulder length, for health and safety reasons, must be tied back with a black or maroon hair tie. Head bands must be black, maroon or school gingham. Hair should be neat and natural in appearance.

 Hijab, or similar head coverings must be in schools colours of maroon, black, grey or white.

The only jewellery permitted at school is one stud in each ear, a watch and a small item of cultural or religious necklace/taonga significance.
